0. Go to the Minneapolis Homepage. <http://www.mpls.k12.mn.us/>
0. Click on the “Students” link.
0. Click on the “Classroom for Success” link. (3<sup>rd</sup> down on the left side)
0. Enter username and password.
0. Select your school
0. Click “Log In”
0. **Click on “View My Assignment Summary”**
0. **Click on “View My Assignments”**

The **password** is their student ID number.

The **username** is the combination of the 1<sup>st</sup> letter of your first name and the first 3 letters of your last name and the last 2 digits of your graduation year and then 01, 02, 03.... This is the same as their email username and in most cases what they use to login to the computer at your school.

For example, if John Doe is an 11<sup>th</sup> grade student his user name would be jdoe0901, jdoe0902 or jdoe0903...  
The last number could get very large depending on the number of students with the same first six characters in the district and the media specialist may need to be contacted for student with common names if they can’t login.
